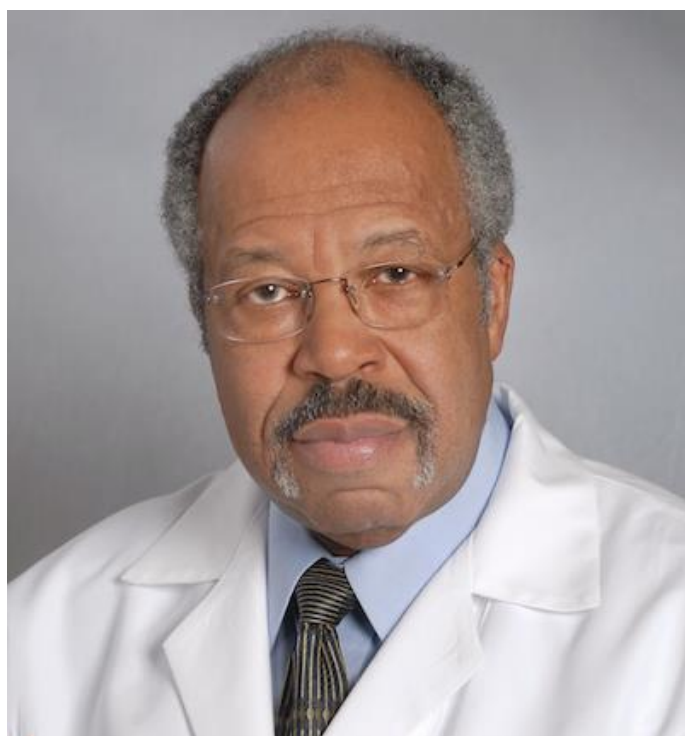

Dr. Wright is a Professor of Medicine and Program Director of the William T. Dahms, MD Clinical Research Unit at University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center. He is also Director of the Clinical Hypertension Program in the Division of Nephrology and Hypertension. An experienced clinical investigator, Dr. Wright's primary research interest is in the clinical pharmacology of antihypertensive and cholesterol lowering agents, especially in minority populations. He has published extensively in this area (over 300 articles, book chapters and abstracts) and has served on many national and international advisory panels.
